Hello!

Well Chrysalis has had a great month. We have heard back from two of the funds I applied for and we have been successful in both. Hurrah! So one lot of funding is for the improvements to the premises; we applied for electrics, heating and new windows. We didn't get the money for electrics and heating, but we got the money for the windows and external door. This will be a huge help in the battle to keep the centre warm, without spending too much on gas. They are due to be fitted near to the end of July. I have a cunning plan to apply for the rest of the money so we can complete the electrics and heating improvements in the autumn.

Other news about the premises is the decoration of the outside of the building. Alex the decorator has done a lovely job and what a difference it has made. It looks bright and fresh and the continuation of our branded yellow stripe pulls the building together and makes the extent of our unit more obvious. It will look even better when the intergenerational project produces the pottery pieces and the hanging baskets etc.

Talking of the IGP – we have made a start. Sheelagh and I attended Chollerton School today and we did our educational presentation to 8 lovely children. They will be coming to Chrysalis next Thursday (16th) and for four weeks after that. We have several members signed up but if anyone wants a last minute place please let us know. We would particularly welcome some extra volunteers if anyone has the time.

Going back to the funding, the second lot of money came from the lottery and is for a marketing project. It will pay for a member of staff who will try and encourage new members and make contacts within the professionals. We feel that, because we are not a business, the income from new members is not crucial, but there are a lot of families out there who haven't even heard of Chrysalis. Some could really benefit from coming along and having fun with us.

The board held a strategy day at the end of last month. It was a very productive day; we had an excellent external facilitator who makes it fun as well as making sure we work hard and stay focused. We started with a review of what we had achieved over the past 5 years, which, even being modest, is quite impressive! We then worked on a three-year plan. It was amazing how we all came up with similar ideas and had similar objectives. So we achieved our goal for the day and then celebrated with a meal out which was great fun and nice for us to spend some time together in a more relaxed atmosphere.

Then May saw the two fundraising events, Mike and his friends making a huge effort to complete their bike ride, and the family fun day held at the end of the month. We are so grateful to people for thinking of Chrysalis when organizing a fundraising event. Because we are a small charity the money goes directly to the people we care about most – our members and their families!

More about singing workshops and how to book them will come with your ticket purchase. Pre-booking of workshops is essential. Workshops are all in physically accessible venues.




The Forum Cinema - dementia friendly showings
